MEET INFORMATION

Late entries. Late entries will be accepted provided that they do not change the nature of the competition in an event, e.g. by necessitating heats where a direct final is scheduled.

Age classes. Master's competition is based on 10-year age classes, class 1, 40-49 years; class 2, 50-59 years; class 3, 60-69 years; class 4, 70 years and over. Age is on the day of competition. However, in any event and 10-year age class, where there are at least six competitors in *each* of the upper and lower 5-year divisions of the 10-year class, separate competitions will be scheduled in each 5-year division, awards going to the first 6 in each division.

In addition, events are scheduled for the submasters division (30-39 years) and there are selected events for women (30 years and over).

Awards—Masters events. The first six finishers in each Masters event (10-year class or 5-year division as outlined above) will receive awards as follows: *1st place*: \$10 coin from the specially minted set of coins celebrating the 1976 Montreal Olympics; *2nd place*: \$5 Olympic coin; *3rd place*: \$5 Olympic coin; *4th, 5th and 6th places*: Canadian silver dollars.

Rather than cancel any events which had less than 6 competitors entered, the organising committee has decided to schedule every event. However, financial considerations make it necessary to offer a reduced scale of awards in such cases. The awards to be made where there are less than 6 entries are as follows:

5 entries: *1st and 2nd*: \$5 Olympic coins; *3rd*: a complete set of uncirculated 1974 Canadian coinage (dollar, half-dollar, quarter, dime, nickel, penny); *4th and 5th*: Canadian silver dollars.

4 entries: *1st and 2nd*: \$5 Olympic coins; *3rd*: coin set; *4th*: silver dollar.

3 entries: *1st*: \$5 Olympic coin; *2nd*: coin set; *3rd*: silver dollar.

2 entries: *1st*: \$5 Olympic coin; *2nd*: coin set.

1 entry: *1st*: \$5 Olympic coin.

In addition, an award will be made to the masters athlete judged the most outstanding of the meet.

Awards—Submasters and women's events. *1st, 2nd and 3rd places*: a complete set of uncirculated 1974 Canadian coinage. *4th, 5th and 6th places*: Canadian silver dollars. Where there are less than 6 entries, the same awards will apply, for as many competitors as take part.

In addition, three awards of \$10 Olympic coins will be made in the submasters division for the three leading performances scored on IAAF scoring tables.

Awards presentation. Awards will be presented immediately after the completion of each competition. The cooperation of award winners in proceeding to the podium area without delay will be much appreciated.

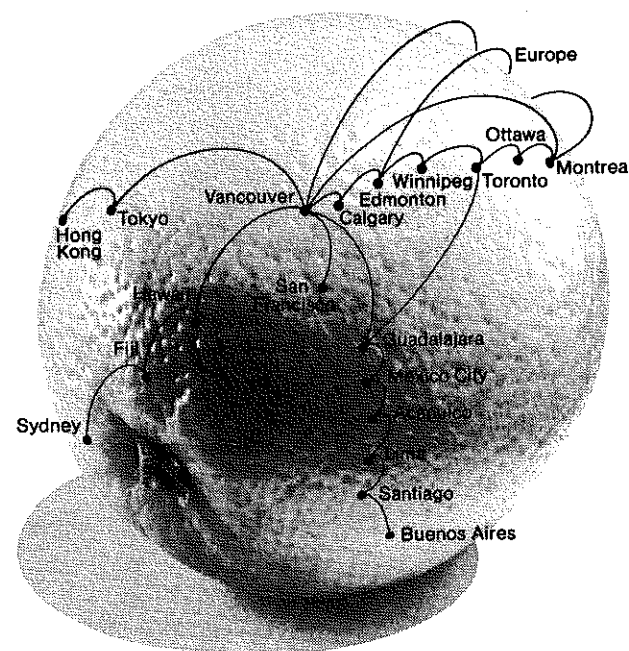
