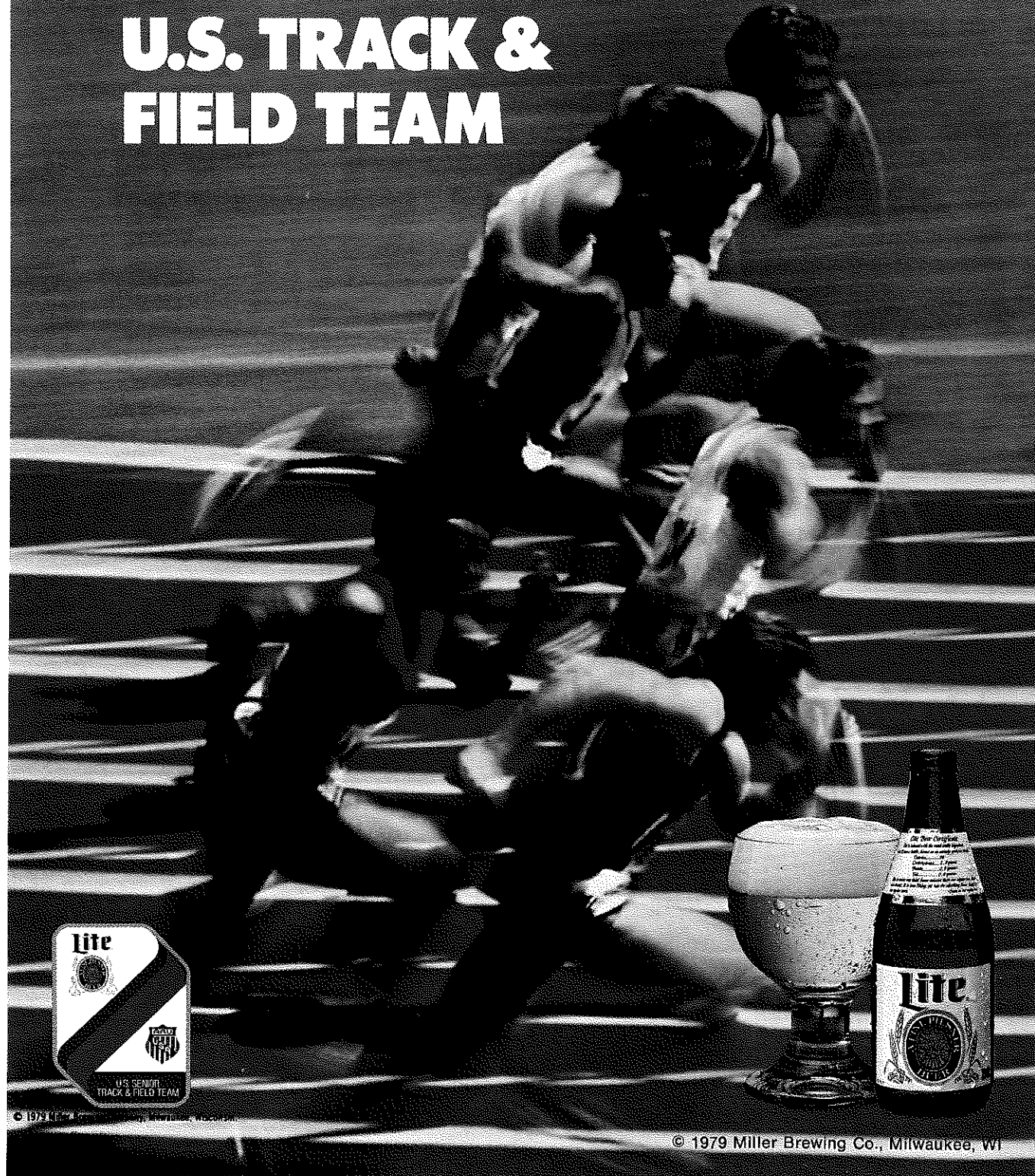

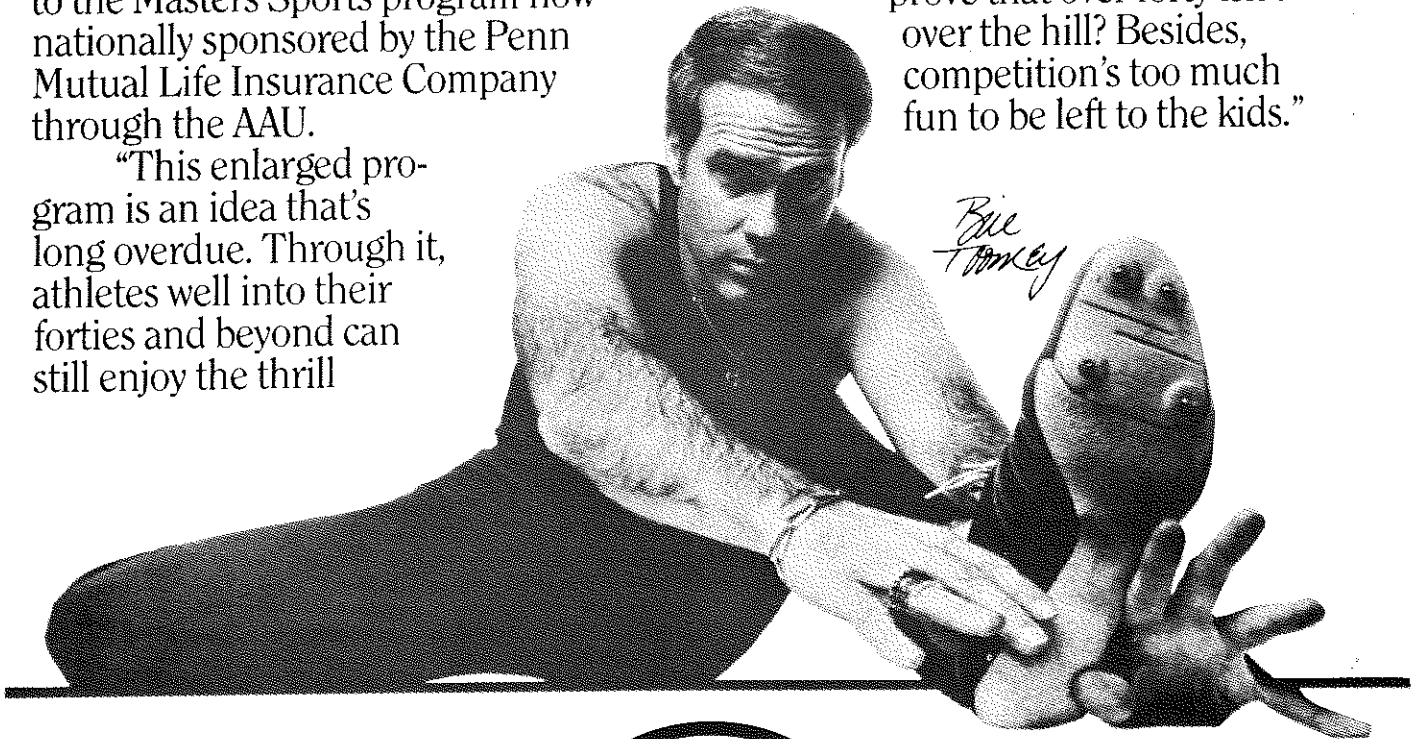

Best wishes for a most successful meet and may the performances of these master athletes encourage other Americans to enjoy this great individual sport.

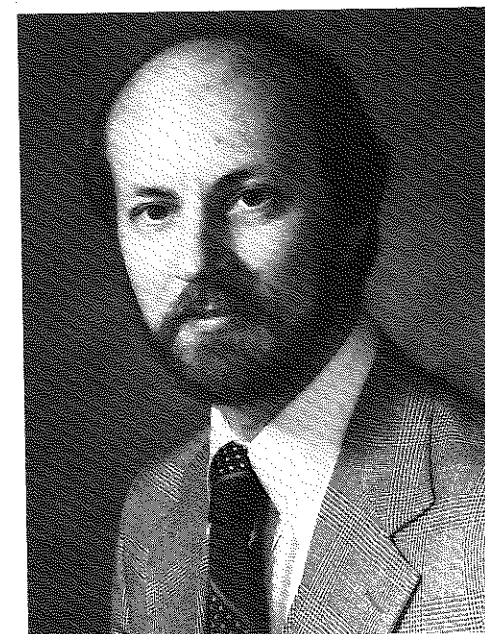
