Judging from queries, the European Veterans Track and Field Championships to be held July 14th - 18th in Strasbourg, France are the focus of more interest than any other upcoming event. Of course medals and titles are rightly limited to Europeans but others have been welcomed as participants provided they accept these terms. We expect to have entry forms and details shortly and would be glad to send them out upon request.

The North American Masters Championships too are the centre of much interest. They will be held in Canada's capital city, Ottawa, August 13th-15th and are part of a sports festival, complete with seminars which will delight everyone.

For the first time, another major W.A.V.A. Championship will take place. The Decathlon (men) and Septathlon (women) will be staged August 28th-29th at the excellent San Diego University facilities. San Diego weather is reputed to be the best in the world. See Ed Oleate's announcement elsewhere in this issue.

Another top class event is one of long standing. The I.G.A.L. (Veteran Road Racing Championships) will be held in Japan and the host is our old friend Hideo Okada happily recovered from his bout with illness and graciously looking forward to welcoming visitors to the Marathon and 10 km events September 15th and 14th respectively. Going not one but two better than ever before, additional optional events of 25 km and 5 km are also offered.

What a job Gijs Knoppert has done once again on the World Veteran Rankings!! What can we say Gijs but "thank you". Please take the time to read Gijs' foreword. Good as his work is he wants to improve it but he must have your cooperation. He needs all results, dates, birthdates, etc.

We are frankly disappointed with the lack of response to letters and articles which appeared in the last issue. Remember that unless you write to us and make known your views we may end up with a one sided program. The Executive will meet in Strasbourg during the European Championships to decide on the finishing touches for Puerto Rico. If you want something changed, added or subtracted please tell us. At least we'll debate it. It is

Ban urged on Olympic boycotts

An International Olympic subcommittee would like to ban boycotts from future Olympic Games, a Canadian Olympic team official said yesterday. Richard Pound, president of the Canadian Olympic Association, said the IOC's Commission for the Protection of the Olympic Games, of which he is chairman, was drafting a resolution that would ask United Nations member states to agree not to use the Games to make political statements. Specifically, the resolution would ask IOC members to avoid boycotts and the denial of access to the Games to any country for political or racial reasons. "The idea is to try to get countries to agree among themselves that the Olympic Games are worth protecting," Pound said. The final draft would be ready for an IOC meeting in Rome next May and, if accepted, would be ready to be taken to the UN by September, Pound said.

PUERTO RICO GETS READY FOR THE FIFTH WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Plans for the organization of the Fifth World Veteran Games in San Juan, Puerto Rico are well under way. The Executive Organizing Committee headed by Roberto Santana, a former athlete and now the Director of the Department of Sports and Recreational Services of the Municipality of San Juan, is meeting every two weeks with the various subcommittees which have been formed in order to stage what will probably be the single most important sports event ever held in the Island.

Although Puerto Rico has hosted important sports activities in the past like the Central American Track and Field Games in 1967 and the Pan American Games in 1979, the W.A.V.A. Games, which will be of international proportions, will have the special significance that the participants will be mostly middle-aged persons in excellent physical conditions. Aside from the obvious economic consequences that the Games will have for the Island (it is expected that close to 7,000 athletes will participate), we expect that these will have a profound influence over the Masters movement in Puerto Rico which now claims a membership of only about 400 out of a population of 3MM people.

Taking these factors into consideration, the objective is to stage the best W.A.V.A. Games ever held. For this purpose, all the relevant Governmental Agencies and Departments and members of the private sector have been incorporated into the organizational structure so that this will be a national event and not just a track and field competition. The Games will be televised locally and bids will be accepted in an effort to

have them also televised live to the United States. The inaugural ceremonies will be held in full-fashion in September 23th in the Hiram Bithorn Stadium (seating capacity 20,000) and will include, besides the usual protocolary procedures, various displays of mosaics and colored banners, a parade of all participating athletes by age categories, a brief meditation guided by Yogi Guru Sri Chinmoy and various artistic and entertaining activities.

There will be no closing ceremonies and the farewell messages by W.A.V.A.'s elected President, a representative of the host country for the Sixth Games, and by the Mayor of San Juan will take place at the Banquet, which promises to be one of the things to be remembered about the Games.

One of the first steps taken has been the recruitment of an Executive Director on a full time basis. For this important job, founder and past President of the Puerto Rico Masters Association, Miguel Rivera Veve was selected. (Miguel is also the local champion pole vaulter in the 2B category and is confident that he will win a medal in the Games.)

One of the most important plans of the organizing committee is to start developing a publicity campaign concerning the Masters movement which should peak just before the celebration of the Fifth World Games. This will increase both the participation of local athletes and to significant numbers the attendance to the Stadia where the events will be held. This campaign will take place through private and public media and will emphasize the social benefits of the Movement, the health related benefits to participants and individual achievements by local and foreign Masters who will be exemplary to the community.

The philosophical framework for the organization of the Games has been provided by San Juan's Mayor Hernán Padilla, a firm supporter of the Masters movement who believes that "...the strength and health of a nation is primarily a function of the strength and health of its members..." Those of us who are active Masters and who enjoy the benefits of the lifestyle which has to be observed in order to become one, fully understand and agree with his remarks. This is why these Games are not just a big track and field event. This is why to us here at this lovely Island to make the Fifth World Games a memorable event constitutes an objective. But that is just part of it. The really important things to our society will come later as more and more people motivated by the great spectacle that the Games will represent, will join the ranks of the healthy, of the strong, of the family minded...because that is what the Masters movement is all about.

We are pleased to inform that the XVth Annual World Championships of Distance Runners will be held at Lake Kawaguchi, Yamanashi Prefecture, Japan, in the middle of September, 1982 on the principles of competitive friendship of IGAL (International Association of Veteran Distance Runners). The race runs along routes surrounding Lake Kawaguchi at the foot of famous Mt. Fuji.

The Nippon Turtles Association and its members of distance runners of Japan who are organizing this annual event will heartily welcome veteran distance runners from all corners of the world coming to Japan for this meet, so that IGAL's idea of international friendship promotion may be successfully achieved on the occasion.

Official races are 10KM road and Marathon (42.195 km). Apart from these official races, optional road races of 25KM and 5KM are specially arranged to familiarize participants with the road conditions prior to the official races. Participation in these races are optional with payment of additional fee which is prescribed later.

Roland Jerneryd's Report (cont'd)

Roland Jerneryd recently visited Puerto Rico with a Swedish Group, here is his report.

Dear Friends,

From our friends in San Juan, Puerto Rico, who are in charge of organizing our next (fifth) World Veteran Athletic Championships 1983 I have the opportunity to send you the actual and best greetings. I have met the Mayor of San Juan, Hernan Padilla, and the members of the organizing committee led by their president Roberto Santana. I have found, during my stay in San Juan, January 6-12, that their organizing work has started very ambitiously. I have the best impressions of their ability to effect fine championships and duties of host. From the Mayor of the City I got the impression that he and his administration will support the realization of memorable, friendly and well-organized championships. Here follows my report:

The Start of the Championships is changed to September 23rd 1983. The opening ceremony will take place in the evening this day in the big baseball arena, Stadio Municipal (Hiram Bithorn) and from the information I have got it will be an unforgettable event.

The General Assembly of the WAVA will be held on the same day, September 23rd 1983, at 10 a.m.

The World Veteran Athletic Championships will be held September 24-30 1983 at the following stadiums:

I Main arena = Escobar Stadium, located in the east end of old (historical) San Juan with tartan tracks (400 metres, 8 lanes). Outside the arena is a 200 m training track (tartan). Close to the Stadium is the big "Olympic" Swimming Stadium.

II Central Park, situated about 3,5 km south of the Escobar Stadium. The arena is equipped with 400 m permanent tracks (chevron 400) and will be used for long distance track runnings and pentathlon.

III Poli deportiva, an arena with a tartan track, 400m, built for the Panamerican Games 1979 as training arena next to the accommodations for the participants of the Games. It is situated about 10 km southeast of the Main Arena. It will be used for long distance track runnings and pentathlon.

Transportation between hotels and sport grounds

The organizing committee promised to examine and prepare the best way of transportsations for all competitors and supporters between hotels and sport grounds, a card, valid during the championships for the metropolitan lines (and a map showing the lines) or some way of chartered buses.

Headquarter for the WAVA executive members

Mr. Gilberto Gonzales-Julia proposed the WAVA executive members to choose the Hotel Caribe Hilton International as their headquarter. I have inspected the hotel and its facilities and have found it excellent. It is located a few minutes walk from the main arena and within walking distance from the centre of the old San Juan.

Forecast regarding number of competitors

Our friends in San Juan think that there will be at least 5000 competitors in the championships 1983. Together with supporters, family members etc it means at least 8000 persons in San Juan connected with the WAVA championships.

International well-known former athletic champions

Our friends in San Juan want us to inform of former international well-known athletes who will take part in the fifth World Veteran Athletic Championships in San Juan 1983 enclosing photo and results.

European Veteran Championships in Strasbourg

The president of the organizing committee 1983, Mr Roberto Santana, and the director of operations, Mr. Miguel Rivera Veve, will come to the Championships in Strasbourg and will bring a lot of programmes for World Veteran Championships to the European veteran competitors.

The women's delegate welcomed everyone to the meeting, especially Argentina and Indonesia who are first-time competitors at the World Championships.

In accordance with the advice of the W.A.V.A. Secretary, Roland Jeneryd, the women's delegate advised the meeting that -

- a) Whilst all present could speak on a motion only one delegate from each country had the right to vote on matters of major policy.
- b) The Chair advised the meeting would be conducted in English, as at Hanover, and hoped interpreters, as requested by the women's delegate, would be able to follow the meeting.

2.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted by Ruth Anderson U.S.A., seconded by Hannelore Guschmann, Belgium.

3.

Women's delegate gave report on her visit to Christchurch 1980, which had previously been sent to all delegates on the mailing list. Hurdle events on New Zealand programme were to be contested as requested from Hannover.

The Women's Delegate stated, having received no mail or proposals in relation to requests made to all countries from the Hannover meeting, it was to be an informal meeting with no agenda. The meeting was then open to general business.

4.

South Africa raised the question of the starting age for Women Veterans which at present, as agreed with the I.A.A.F., was 35 years and over. After a great deal of discussion the motion was taken that the age group be altered to 40,

and Pre Veterans W35-39; seconded by Ruth Anderson, U.S.A.

Before the vote was taken we had to establish the delegates who were eligible to vote. The motion was lost by one vote. Delegates were again asked to ascertain the view of their own country and report to the Women's Delegate before the next World Championships. Canadian women themselves asked for a lower age group to be considered.

A firm proposal on this would need to be forthcoming before the next world championships.

5.

With regard to relay teams a number of women expressed disappointment in the fact that no relays would be contested in Puerto Rico as decided by the General Assembly Delegates.

6.

Delegates were again asked to forward further suggestions to the Women's Delegate as she was rather disappointed with the lack of communication of the last two years.

The Women's Delegate thanked Mr. Gijs Knoppert and other men who attended for their interest shown.

Members were asked to support Mr. Knoppert, the Women's Statistician, by letting him have as complete a list as possible by the 31st December each year at the following address:

The Women's Delegate called for nominations for the new Women's Delegate as she had not received any by post for 1981/83. None were forthcoming and the majority agreed for her to continue in that position for the next two years.

The Women's Delegate thanked everyone for attending and wished them well in competition.

Randall, Fox Win National 10K Cross Country

UNITED STATES Lorenz, Hatton Surprised

HOUSTON, Nov. 21 — Kirk Randall, who had not run a cross-country race in 18 years, outdistanced an elite field of master harriers today to win the Penn Mutual/TAC National Masters 10-kilometer cross-country championships along the banks of Buffalo Bayou.

Randall, 40, a professional squash player from Wellesley, Mass. covered the distance in 34:10 to surprise the likes of Herb Lorenz, Ray Hatton, David

Hambly, Jim Ewing and Dan Conway. Judy Fox, 41, successfully defended her national women's championship over the challenging, two-loop course in 42:12. The former Palo Alto, Cal. resident, now living in Durham, N.C., finished 20 seconds ahead of Linda Sippelle, 46, of Santo Domingo, who claimed the 45-49 crown.

Country

Randall, who turned 40 in August, led Lorenz, 43, virtually all the way for a 5-second victory. Hatton, 49, was 20 seconds further back to cop the 45-49 national title. Defending champion Hambly was 4th in 34:43.

Randall sprinted into an early lead, but didn't gain an edge over Lorenz until after two miles. Randall said he made the most of a series of inclines. "Once I got the lead, it was very hard for anybody to make it up," he said.

IN ANSWER TO LETTER FROM CHRISTINE WALKER (CANADA) PUBLISHED JUNE 1982
IN NEWSLETTER NO. 5.

Dear Christine:

What a novel way to correspond, if this catches on we may have something to put on the agenda at the next meeting.

I certainly appreciated hearing from you even per medium of the WAVA Newsletter. I have noted your suggestions and will keep them well documented for future meetings and the next Women's Delegate.

My address is published inside of the front cover of this newsletter and should any other women delegate or veteran women care to correspond and send suggestions and/or motions, proposals, ideas and news of what is happening in their own country, perhaps some good may come of it for the future of veteran women's athletics. Briefly, to answer some of your points -

1. Minutes had been sent to all known delegates.
2. Interpreters were asked to be on hand. The few delegates who needed them informed me they would bring their own, which they did.
3. I needed answers, plus proposals etc. to formulate an agenda.
4. Seating Arrangements. I was asked to keep a low profile on the nationalistic side of the meeting (for obvious reasons). The stadium manager kindly made a room available free of charge, but due to the many disruptions, he and/or his staff were unable to set up the seats within the room.
5. The time and place of the meeting had to be changed often, due to many notifications of late arrivals of delegates and competitors. (In the future the Women's Delegate will need to know well in advance where each country's delegate is staying, name and telephone number.)

Identification of Delegates, if you so request - perhaps each delegate could bring a small flag from her own country and/or name the country on a badge, etc.

Note - Was again asked at Christchurch to keep down the nationalistic side of delegates in case of disruptions. In fact the whole of the championships were supposed to have been low-key in relation to nations, e.g.

- a) Competitors marched onto the arena in age groups instead of countries.
- b) Delegates at the General Assembly sat together.
6. Nominations and proposals had been called for in plenty of time (none received). Usually each country votes their own women delegate into office before the games. I had received five names of the delegates who would be in attendance at the meeting.

The remainder I assumed were still in office from the previous games at Hanover, 1979.

Note - I would appreciate notification of any delegate changes plus names and addresses.

Some delegates confused the meeting at Christchurch by not knowing which one was representing their country. We seemed to have two from Canada, two from USA, four from New Zealand and one from the country we are not suppose to mention, who had not submitted a delegate's name.

May I suggest that all countries take note of their own current women's delegate and help to keep her up to date on current information.

Christine, I have taken the liberty of forwarding you a personal copy of this letter, also copies of previous correspondence for your information, plus current minutes from the Christchurch meeting. Consideration will be given to your suggestions, and any others forwarded to me.

I was new to the position, but thanks to women like yourself and the Veterans Association I am gaining knowledge and know-how all the time, plus hopefully, making new friends.

On the Relay issue, I must admit that I agree with Fred Smith's letter. The Championships do seem to lean towards the distance runners in relation to team events and participation. I too (along with many others) was very disappointed with the delegates at the General Assembly voted to have the relays disbanded from the program at Puerto Rico. Can we do anything to alter this???

OAKLAND, Cal. Dec. 6 — Sister Marion Irvine, the 52-year-old Flying Nun, ran the fastest marathon ever by a woman over age 50 today, with a stunning time of 2 hours, 55 minutes, 16.6 seconds in the 3rd Annual Oakland Marathon.

Diane Palmason, 43, of Ottawa, Canada, and Karen Scannell, 43, of San Francisco became the only two sub-2:50 over-40 women marathoners in the U.S. in 1981, Palmason outdueling Scannell, 2:49:26 to 2:49:47.

Palmason lowered her own Canadian masters record of 2:53 to finish 3rd woman

Irvine, the Dominican nun from San Rafael, Cal., bested the previous world best for women over age 50 — a 2:57:14 by New Jersey's Toshiko d'Elia in the World Veterans Marathon championships in Glasgow, Scotland in 1980.

Overall Scannell, the 1980 U.S. woman master-of-the-year, broke 2:50 for the first time, placing 4th overall.

Pat Thomas, 41, of Seattle was 3rd woman master in 2:54:04. Pat Whittingslow, 41, of Oakland ran 2:58:25 for a total of five masters under 3 hours.

Something to Think About

Just a couple of things, in haste, as I am getting ready to leave for an I.A.A.F. Committee meeting in Milan, Italy, this coming week-end.

Some strong suggestions have been made by Australia that events for older athletes be decreased in future championships. Many people do not realize how rapidly the number of older W.A.V.A. athletes are increasing and how much their performances are improving.

From recent championships and other events I have collected a list (incomplete) of 40 recent competitors, who have had good performances, and who are now past 80 years old or will be before the next W.A.V.A. Championships in Puerto Rico in 1983. Half of these 40 showing up for an average of 3 or 4 events give surprising competition in the 80-84 age group. There could be quite a few at the N.A. championships this year in Ottawa.

I have been waiting for the ranking lists from Haig Bohigian (due before now) to prepare a point scale for the 80-84 age group and will complete this as soon as the lists arrive.

A new, radically different point scale was approved by the I.A.A.F. in September for implementation in April, but because of many protests regarding it, its use is being postponed. It was going to be much tougher in the throwing events than the 1962 I.A.A.F. scale but it went too far at the lower and medium levels.

I am hoping to get the most recent information on both the men's and women's scale at the meeting as we try to keep our continuation of theirs into older age groups if they end up reasonable.

I will be in touch when I get back. Best wishes for 1982

Late in 1980, having reached his fiftieth birthday, he ran a series of five 10's - the fastest 54:22, the slowest 55:32. In 1981 he ran faster! Running only two 10's he produced 53:16 and 53:26. Needless to say he took the over-fifties prize each time.

In the December '81 Midland Vets Newsletter he had to say, "It has not been easy going. I had more than my fair share of colds last year, but none of the important week-ends. I always have some aches and pains and minor injuries, that can be expected now I've turned 50. If I rested every time I had problems I would never get out training....I do not train hard or fast because I believe it's impossible to train hard and race hard. You have to decide which is the most important, training or racing... There are no easy races, it hurts just as much at the front of the field as it does at the back....I am, however, going to ease off with my running in the future. I achieved what I planned for during my first year in the over fifties group, so I am satisfied. At times I even think of retiring from athletics".

Retire indeed! With times like that. But maybe one can understand the feeling for Alan must have worked hard in recent years to achieve what he has. Although he claims to train easily he does a 70 a week if he does not have a race, and 55 if he races. He competes often. In the first 8 months of '81 he had 19 races. Some of these produced fast times, 800 in 2:11.9, 1500 in 4:17.4 and a British record for 5000 with 16:00.0. I don't think he's ready to bow out yet, do you?

Athletics Congress National Masters 5000 m
Cross Country Championships

Balboa Park, San Diego, California, November 28, 1981. Pain, 55° F.

What is cross Country without a bit of rain, puddles and mud? Just another hilly road race. Old Jupiter Pluvius dumped enough water during the night before the race to provide a wet course, sprinkled on the sub-masters mens' race, then just as the ladies were set to toe the line he pulled the plug. Down came the rain, off went the gun and away went the gals into the downpour. 45 minutes later the masters men lined up to the tune of 60° and sunshine! But they still had puddles and mud galore, and a good shippin' 'n' shlidin' race.

Shortly after one mile the course goes down "powder" hill and onto the "dirt" trail, neither of which were. The hills in that second mile make it a slow one, then it's up the switchback hill and across the grass to the short mile of slightly down-sloping sidewalk and a final 500 yards of grass and dirt to finish.

This race is many individual battles against self, opponents, hills and footing. Attack the shortest route or go a half-step further on secure ground? Push this hill or save something for that stretch of sidewalk? Is the pre-race plan still good or has an opponent done something unanticipated and must strategy be adapted to counter his tactics? Time and distance zip by as these "encounters" unfold and we progress to the nitty gritty: the run to the finish. If the course failed to san everything it's "go city" to the line and the chance to breath and recover.

A couple of early hills and some slippery running notwithstanding, the leaders passed one mile at about 5 minutes flat with Bob Mohler of Houston leading Frank Duarte, Dan McCaskill, Skip Shaffer and Bill Meinhardt. They zipped down Powder Hill and some changes occurred. Duarte and Shaffer passed Mohler and began to pull away with Meinhardt going by McCaskill and moving on Mohler. 46 year old Andre Tocco had started well back and worked his way methodically up the line of runners until he passed McCaskill on Switchback Hill to go into 5th place. Clearing the hill and moving down the sidewalk, McCaskill regained 5th and with about a mile to go the first 6 places were established though those gentlemen certainly had to work to protect them to the finish.

The 50-54 men had an interesting race. At one mile Tom Sturak, Bill Stock and Del Teter were hanging closely together in 5:30sh.. Stock passed Sturak going down Powder and on the trail everyone strung out a bit. At 2 miles Stock led by about 30 yards which increased to 32 seconds at the finish. With Sturak in 24th place over-all, there were 8 50-54's in the next 10 places over a span of 30 seconds. That's pretty close competition!

The womens' race was pretty well spread out in all divisions excepting 45-49. The winner of the race was Jenny Wright who attended College of the Desert this fall and the 46 year old swiftie was the top runner for their women's XC team! The first 3 finishers were in the 45-49 division with Vicki Bielow barely hanging on to edge Dorothy Stock for the silver medal. The 30 yard lead Vicki had with 400 to go dwindled to 2 at the line. And both looked absolutely terrible as they were holding back nothing for tomorrow. Neophytes seeing them 10 minutes later running side by side warming down and chattering like magpies would not have believed it. If appearances counted they'd both have been headed for the hospital! The recovery rate of well conditioned athletes is amazing.







The study of magazines: WAVAS-Newsletter, National Masters Newsletter(USA) and Leichtatletik(GFR).

It is a pity to declare that nothing was sent to me from the USA, Canada, Australia, New-Zealand, Africa, South-America and the not-mentioned European countries.

Till now this is a most ridiculous way to come to serious statistics.

Again: There ought to be more accuracy about details of wind-assistance by sprinting and jumping. Heights of hurdles and weights by shot, discus, javelin and hammer are different at several occasions and are often lacking to be accounted in the results of championships.

Birthdates are of the highest importance to trace the age-groups. In many cases the knowledge of the correct year of birth is nearly worthless to me in consideration of the fact, that several athletes are proceeding from the one age-group to the other in the midst of the season. A number of performers are enlisted in different age-groups as you will see. So the national compiler has to be aware of this.

As most handbooks of the ATFS appear in july and august it seems a more appropriate procedure to set a deadline for information by 1 august every year and to fix the publication in the beginning of september.



BLAZE OF GLORY FOR SINGAPORE'S FORMER STAR BARNABAS

Strongman Sibidol's fury turns into ecstasy...

BRUNEI'S Aloysiuss Sibidol's fury turned into ecstasy when he broke the world record of 53.50m during the fourth world veterans' meet at Christchurch in January. The record then was 53m, also set by Bill. Where in the world did the organisers get that distance of 54.08m?"

But, Hari Chandra, vice-president of the Asian Veterans' Athletics Federation said: "I did make a mistake for the shot put — the record should read as 15.10m — but there's no mistake for the javelin."

Sibidol's visit to Singapore started on the wrong foot when he was surprised to find the world shot put distance had been misprinted in the official programme as 16.40 metres.

Sibidol's temperature hit boiling point when the world javelin record read as 54.08m, set by Ameri-

can Bill Moralis in 1977. He fumed: "How can that be? I set the world record of 53.50m during the fourth world veterans' meet at Christchurch in January."

"The record then was 53m, also set by Bill. Where in the world did the organisers get that distance of 54.08m?"

But Sibidol threw both distances into oblivion, anyway, with a superb 15.40m for the shot put, and 54.20m for the javelin.

In his fifth attempt for the shot put, Sibidol had already broken the record with a throw of 15.29m,

but his sixth and final effort added another 11 centimetres to earn him the accolade.

Such was Sibidol's joy that an unwary woman received a warm bear-hug and a kiss from Brunei's strongman.

tance to America for ratification, and they confirmed it."

But Sibidol still was not satisfied — he wanted to prove a point by shattering the world record. He did it in his next throw, and his anger was finally satiated.

It was still not enough, for he immediately began planning to break his two new distances at the fifth World Veterans meet in Puerto Rico next year.

Said Hari: "We have to send his distances to the World Veterans' Federation for ratification, but as this was an organised meet, following International Athletic Association

regulations, there's no way that they won't recognise them."

Singapore's former track queen Glory Barnabas, too, gave a equally rousing performance, streaking past her rivals to cap a fine sprint double in the 100m and 200m in 13.3 sec and 26.7 respectively.

But, while Glory's feats switched on feelings of patriotism, the performances of India's Jarnal Singh and Gulab Singh brought on gasps of amazement.

Jarnal, 59, and Gulab, who at 77 is the oldest competitor in the meet, took top honours in all the events in their respective age-groups.
